1. Operation:

All USBC rules and regulations will govern this tournament unless specifically waived below. All entrants must check in no later than 30 minutes prior to their assigned times.

2. Eligibility

All entrants must be at least 14 years old and be a current member of an USBC Association. If not local association, entrants must provide average verification from their Association Manager. USBC cards must be presented at check in.

3. Entering Average

All entrants must use their highest 23-24 USBC winter average. Any bowler without a 23-24 winter average may use 2024 summer league average based on 21 or more games, provided they submit a written verification. All others will bowl scratch. The tournament management reserves the right to adjust any bowler's average upward prior to their participation in the tournament. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than their actual average. If reported average is higher than actual average, the higher average will be used for this tournament. All averages must correspond to bowling style. (Entrants bowling right-handed must use right-handed average and handicap, while entrants bowling left-handed must use left-handed average and handicap. 10 pin rule is waived. Rule 319D Applies (reporting prior prize money's Certified or Non-Certified)

4. Handicap

All prizes will be on a handicap basis. The handicap will be 90% of the entrant's average from 240 scratch based on 21 games or more.

5. Multiple Participation

Reentries are permitted for up to 30 minutes of squad time providing there is space available. However, entrants may cash only once. Entry submitted prior to the tournament day will have priority as far as securing spots within a desired squad.

6. Bowler's Responsibility

It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify his or her average.

7. Fees

Fees will not be refunded after the entry form and fees have been received and squad times assigned.

8. Awards

All prize monies will be returned 100% on a ratio of at least (1) prize for each (8) entries. In the event of a tie for the championship, prize monies will be equally divided. Any youth prize money will be sent to SMART account.
