#### **TOURNAMENT RULES**

- 1. <u>Eligibility</u>; All Women members of the SMC USBC are eligible to enter provided they have been an SMC USBC member 30 days prior to their scheduled tournament bowling.
- 2. <u>Handicap</u>; All prizes shall be on a handicap basis. The handicap shall be computed on an individual basis of 90% of 240. Averages to be used in this tournament (In order of precedence) shall be the bowler's highest USBC (21 game average) for the 2023-24 winter, 2024 summer, or Jan 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025 as listed on <u>Bowl.com</u>. A bowler who doesn't have any averages listed previously may use a current average of 21 or more games with a supplied verification. <u>Bowlers who have a sport league average ONLY must use their readjusted average</u>. If a bowler has been rerated or refused a rerate in the past 10 years, it must be reported at time of entry.
- **3.** <u>Divisions and Classes</u>: The 18<sup>th</sup> Annual Women's Tournament is a 9 Pin No Tap Singles Competition with Optional Virtual Doubles available.

Singles:

Division A competition shall be an average of 165 and higher.

Division B competition shall be an average of 164 and lower.

Virtual Doubles (optional, not required):

Division A competition shall be based on combined averages of 330 and higher.

Division B competition shall be based on combined averages of 329 or lower.

- \*\*Enter Doubles on site, day of tournament. Can enter with multiple partners.
- 4. Awards: Awards will be awarded to the handicap leaders in each division. Prize fund will be based on 1:6 entries.
- 5. PBA/PWBA Members: Two PBA/PWBA members may not enter as doubles partners.
- **6.** <u>Dress Code:</u> All bowlers must wear a shirt with sleeves. Slacks, Shorts, Skirts & Jeans in neat clean appearance will be allowed. The following apparel is **NOT PERMITTED** sweats, tank tops, halter-tops, or T-Shirts with inappropriate writing/design on them. No head gear.
- 7. Rules number 319a (10 Pin) and 319d (prize winnings) are waived for this tournament.
- 8. <u>All Winnings</u> in Any SMCUSBC Tournament or Bracket Pay Outs of of \$600 or more in 1 calendar year, said bowler will receive a 1099 form from the Local Association, You Must Provide a Social Security Number to Association Manager or **FORFEIT** all Prize Monies Earned. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 9. Any rules not listed will be covered by the USBC 23-24 Rule Book.
